called to report Christian Morgan at his door harassing him and wanted him trespassed. Upon arrival I made contact with Christian and advised him that he can not return to the property and if he does he will be arrested. He stated he understood and departed the residence.

TRESPASS:

I told Christian that as of this moment he was trespassed from the Incident location

Benjamin Schneider was trespassed from the property the day prior to this incident.

VEHICLE CONTACT:

As I was departing the incident location, I watched Christian attempt to get into a black Hyundai Elantra.

The initial comment by Christian was that Ben was somewhere around the location and is the one that dropped him off. Therefore when I witnessed Christian attempt to get into this vehicle, I initially my emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle as it was involved in my incident of harassing

I approached the vehicle and came in contact with Tyler Shaw (trespassed yesterday) and Benjamin Schneider (trespassed yesterday) who were both in the vehicle. And Christian turned away from the vehicle and took off from the location. Officers could not locate him while on scene with the vehicle.

I looked into the vehicle and asked if that was Ben in the back of the vehicle and he said yes. I then told him that they were both involved in the incident yesterday and then they attempted to lie and say that the church sent the Christian.

Tyler acted like he did not know what I was talking about and stated that he had just met the guy a few hours ago. I then told him, I know he was the one that sent Christian to the house, to harass and he acted like he did not know what I meant either.

For the first few minutes of my interaction with both Tyler and Ben, they acted like the church had sent Christian and that they had nothing to do with it. But then later on, Ben admitted that he sent Christian and someone else in an attempt to at least get in contact with because he civil court case could not go through until they tried to verbally handle the situation between eachother.

I told them to call Christian and tell him to come back to the vehicle then because he had ditched out towards another house and was avoiding coming to the vehicle.

I told Benjamin to provide his I.D to Officer Fraughton while I conducted a records check of the report from yesterday.

I also asked Officer Fraughton to verify with the driver if what I noticed was accurate in his eyes. As they were glossy and seemed to have a red layer of tint in them.

RECORDS REPORT:

I checked the report from Officer Tonga Case # 26AF01974

It was documented that Tyler Shaw and Benjamin Schneider were at the same address then that they were close by today. However, in the previous case they asked another random person by the name of Benjamin Adams to be there to.

Today's incident is similar in nature, that Tyler and Benjamin, asked Christian to go to house again and to harass the reporting party in this case.

FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS:

From this portion on in my investigation I did not realize my body cam was muted. Therefore there will be no sound from this moment on.

Officer Fraughton stated that he believed Tyler's eyes were glossy as well and seemed to provide the same tint I saw. Therefore I made contact with Tyler and told him that I would like him to conduct Field Sobriety tests to make sure he was safe to drive. Tyler consented.

As he walked out to the car, I asked him to step onto the sidewalk so that I may start explaining the tests. I started asking Tyler about his eyes and if he had any head injuries, he stated he had a concussion in high school but that was it. I started to explain the first test, being the eye test. I asked Johnny if he had a resting nystagmus. He asked what that was so I took that as a no. I observed Tyler having hazel eyes, with a red tint to them.

As I started explaining the test, Tyler was paying attention and stated he understood the test and the requirements. As for this test, I did not observe any clues.

As I started explaining the second test, I asked Tyler if he had any injuries with his legs or with his balance and he stated no. Tyler attempted to start the test before I had even started to explain it. During this instruction he was attentive and stated that he did not have any questions. Tyler stated that he did have a bad ankle though but that was it.

As I told Tyler the position to be in, I asked him if he understood and he stated yes. I told him to remain in the position until told to start. When I explained to not start until told to begin he understood.

As the test started, I observed Tyler raise his arms once on the first run and then stop at the turn and make an improper turn. Therefore I observed three clues on this test.

As I started to explain the third test, Tyler seemed attentive and had no questions. After I asked Johnny if he had any question he stated no, and then I told him to begin. During this test I did not observe any clues.

Due to my findings I told Tyler that I had more investigating to do. And I requested that Tyler do a portable breath test. He consented and blew a .000 BrAc.

I told Tyler that as of this moment, I wanted him to wait on by the curb while I spoke with Ben.

K9:

I requested the assistance of Officer Fraughton's K9 Bane.

He conducted an open air sniff around the vehicle and alerted to the vehicle.

CONTACT BEN:

I spoke with Ben while I requested officer Fraughton conduct his open air sniff.

Ben was stating that he is a youtuber and he goes around to different places and conducts investigations into these corrupt or illegal institutions. I asked Benjamin what was the point of yesterday's interactions with [redacted] and he stated that [redacted] is a corporate employee that has taken over Bricks and Minifigs and had stolen money from the previous customer's contract with the company. He stated that his employer had hired him to get in contact with [redacted] and to try and get his money back.

He stated that he has been trying to do that because the civil court in Oregon has told him they can not go to court civilly until he has at least try to verbally handle the situation with the other party.

I told him the way that he had been doing that however got him into a situation where now he can not go back to the residence at all and that he was trespassed. He stated that he knew.

But then I asked him what was the situation with the UPS incident. Ben stated that he had Tyler deliver a package of ducks to [redacted] and had him sign a face piece of document on his phone, that way he could use the signature later in order to make a contract where [redacted] could not trespass anyone or him for the next five years.

I asked Ben if he realized how illegal that was federally. To dress up as UPS and fake deliver a package then steal a signature. Ben stated that he did not see the issue with that. I told Ben that as of this moment, the police K9 alerted and the vehicle is going to be searched.

SEARCH:

The search was conducted by Officer Fraughton and I, but nothing of note or substance was located in the vehicle.

RELEASE:

I told both Tyler and Benjamin that they were walking a thin line on harassment and stalking with [redacted]. That they keep going back to his residence and sending different people to bother him or attempt to get in contact with him. I told them both that they as well as Christian are trespassed and can not go back. That they need to find a civil way to solve the problem with [redacted] that does not include going to his house and sending random people there.

DISPOSITION:
